### *Dear Parents of Morning Car Riders,*

With more morning car riders, **our daily goal remains to have all students in their classrooms by 7:40, our official instructional start time.** We need your help in the following ways:

- Please use your time waiting in line to have your child **ready to unload promptly** to the right (curb) side.
  - The first 10 minutes (7:10-7:20) currently offer **no delays or back-ups.**
  - Please do not park & walk your child into school unless you have a meeting or are volunteering. This slows down the car line for others as traffic has to be stopped.
  - Your placement in the car line prior to 7:40 does not guarantee your student will not be tardy. Your student must be inside the building in their classroom by 7:40am to be considered on time for the school day per school district and state requirements.
  - **Any students arriving after 7:40** will generally be considered tardy and should be accompanied into the office and signed in by a parent (per school, district, and state requirements).

Ice cream is available in the cafeteria for \$1.25!



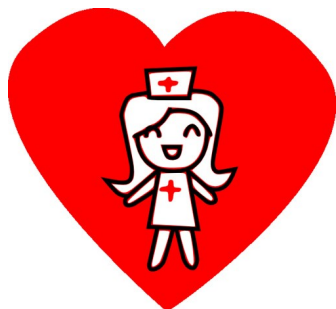

### *Notes from the Nurse:*

#### **SHOULD YOUR CHILD BE AT SCHOOL?**



Each year South Carolina DHEC publishes guidelines for when students should stay home from school due to illness. We will be highlighting excerpts from **The School and Childcare Exclusion List** every month in the Rocket Report.

***Vomiting:*** Keep young children home when vomiting has occurred 2 or more times in a 24 hour period, or for vomiting and fever (101 or higher). All children should stay home for any green or bloody vomit. If the child is vomiting and also has not urinated for 8 hours the child should stay home. Your child may return with a parent note.

***Medications:*** Please refer to the student handbook located in the front of the student agenda in regards to prescription and non-prescription medication health room procedures.

### **Quick Attendance Reminder:**

When taking your student to the doctor, please obtain a school excuse for any absence, tardy or dismissal from school.
